2010 International Training Details (in Cleveland, OH, USA).

- Held at our World Engineering Technology Center in Cleveland, Ohio, USA, this program offers a combination of hands-on welding training and technical classroom discussions with each major welding process. Technical assignments will be given to each attendee which will require evening study.
- Course hours are from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
- Course is offered in **ENGLISH LANGUAGE** only.

1. Reservations
